Greetings from the heart of the Ozarks to all of our 25th MP Company Alumni! We have a great reunion planned for all of you, your spouses, and guests this year. Here is some key information you'll need to know.

Lodging. The Hampton Inn is conveniently located minutes from the main gate of Ft. Leonard Wood, the home of the Military Police Corps Regiment. They have pledged to provide our travelers a warm and inviting "home away from home" experience. The room rate is \$94.00 + taxes per night. This rate and the reservation block for 25th MP Company alumni will be held until July 22, 2017. Guestrooms not confirmed after this date will be released to the general public and reservations will be subject to availability. The rooms feature comfort and convenience, large work desks and convenient lap desks, and in-room amenities include:

- One King or two double beds
- Free on-site parking
- Free high-speed internet access
- Free hot breakfast (or Grab & Go for busy sightseers)
- 24 hour coffee/tea in the lobby
- Fresh cookies in the afternoon
- Iron/Ironing board
- Hair dryer
- Gym/fitness center
- Room service

Please call the Hampton Inn at (573) 336-3355 and ask for the 25th MP Reunion reservation block. Reservations must be made by **Saturday, July 22, 2017.** There are no available hotel shuttle services. Once we fill this block of rooms, the Guest Services Staff of the Hampton Inn will gladly make reservations for you at the same rate in the adjacent Comfort Inn, located just 75 feet away.

Airport Transportation. For those air travelers that choose to fly to this year's reunion, I recommend that you fly into the St. Louis Lambert International Airport, 10701 Lambert International Blvd, St. Louis, MO 63145. This airport is approximately 148.6 miles from the hotel. It services most major air carriers - American, Delta, United, Southwest, and many others.

Another option is the Springfield-Branson National Airport, 2300 N Airport Blvd, Springfield, MO 65802. This is a smaller, regional airport with limited flights and services. This airport is approximately 95.6 miles from the hotel.

Getting to the Hampton Inn from the Airport. Once at Lambert International Airport, you have several options to get to the hotel in the Waynesville-St. Robert area.

- 1) You may opt for a connecting flight through Cape Air to the Waynesville-St. Robert Regional Airport (Forney Field), which is located on Fort Leonard Wood. Call Cape Air's direct booking line at 1-866-Cape-Air (1-866- 227-3247) or book online at www.capeair.com.
 - There is only one rental car agency at this airport: Hertz, (573) 329-6688. However, Enterprise, (573) 336-7355, will service you from St. Robert.
 - Taxi service is also available from this airport:
 - Post Cab Company/(573) 336-0111, City Cab/(573) 336-3831, Gray's Taxi/(573) 336-7433, or Yellow Cab/(573) 336-5777
- 2) You may take the USA Express Shuttle Service from Lambert International Airport directly to the hotel. The cost is \$223 for 1 person (roundtrip) or \$335 for 2 persons (roundtrip). Hospitality Room. The hospitality room will be located in the southwest corner of the first floor of the hotel. **It's the largest room in the Hampton Inn!** It is a 2,142 sq. ft. meeting room equipped with all of the important features, to include free WiFi, and can accommodate up to 150 of our alumni, family members, and guests. So kick back, relax, and take as much elbow room as you need. The hospitality room will be open Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 8:00 am – 12:00 am. Snacks and beverages will be provided, as well as a light lunch on these days. We will have an open bar, but alcoholic beverages must stay in the hospitality room. Smoking is allowed just about anywhere outside of the hotel. A dedicated hotel staff member will be on hand to ensure that the food remains hot and beverages stay cold.

- Trap Tournament at the Outdoor Adventure Center, 10:00 – 11:30 am, located on Fort Leonard Wood (**Need a minimum of 6 participants**)
 - Trap shooting is a recreational activity where participants, using shotguns, attempt to break clay targets that are mechanically flung into the air
 - Cost is \$14 per round, which includes fees for shotgun rental, ammunition, and clay targets; shooters typically shoot 2 rounds for a total cost of **\$28**
- Bowling Tournament at the Daugherty Bowling Center, 12:00 – 3:00 pm, located on Fort Leonard Wood (**Need a minimum of 6 participants**)
 - Cost is \$2.50 per game, bowling shoes are **free**
 - Bowlers typically bowl 3 games for a total cost of **\$7.50**
 - A wide array of food and beverages are available at the bowling alley
- Ladies Sip and Paint, 2:30 – 4:30 pm, Hampton Inn (**Need a minimum of 12 participants**)
 - Fun and relaxing painting session, facilitated by an art instructor
 - Enjoy wine and snacks; best venue of its kind in south-central Missouri
