Howdy from deep in the heart of Texas! We are very excited that y'all are coming our way this year.

Lodging: The Inn of the Hills is a beautiful motel and conference center widely known and respected in our area. You need to call and make your reservations ASAP, if you have not already done so. The cutoff date for our rate is September 17, 2018, however... and this is **important...**there is no elevator in this two-floor motel, so if you need a ground floor room, make your reservation early and request one. They do have lots of them but don't wait till the last minute!!!! Request the 25th Military Police Group rate.

The motel has their own restaurant and offers guests a full breakfast buffet at a discounted rate of \$7.95 per person plus tax, **but it must be ordered prior to arrival in order for them to be prepared for our number for breakfast!** We will be providing donuts and pastries each morning in the Hospitality Suite, plus there is a Chick Fil A directly across the street for those just wanting something light, as well as several other restaurants in the area.

Airport: The closest large airport is San Antonio International airport, which is 66.4 miles from the Inn of the Hills.

Directions from I-10 to the Inn: Take Exit 505, toward Kerrville. The third traffic light is at Junction Highway, turn left and immediately get into the right lane. Inn of the Hills is the second building on the right. They have a digital display and it will be welcoming us!

Hospitality Suite: When you register, we will give you a map with directions to both the Hospitality Suite and the Bluebonnet Room (where our evening events will be held.) Get ready for some down-home Texas relaxation. Snacks and drinks will be available.

Hospitality suite will be open: Thursday, Friday, and Saturday 8am-10pm except during events in the Bluebonnet Room in the evenings.

Reunion Fee: The reunion fee this year is \$115 per person. This will cover the cost of the following:

8:00am Assemble in the Hospitality Suite to prepare for 8:30 departure via charter bus (limited to the first 56 participants) for the YO Ranch Headquarters. The YO Ranch is nationally famous for its history and abundance of exotic animals from around the world. It is home to as many exotics as any ranch in the United States. The history and operation of the ranch will be explained on site. The tour will be in an open-air vehicle, so come prepared for sun and temperature. The guided tour will end with a Texas style Bar-B-Que. **Cost of the tour and lunch is \$45.** Return to the motel approx. 3:00pm.

Saturday, October 20, 2018

8:45am assemble in Hospitality Suite to prepare for 9:15am departure via charter bus (limited to the first 56 participants) for Fredericksburg, Texas (a quaint Traditional German town with numerous shops and sights) for two stops:

- 1)** The Pioneer Museum: Historical lifestyle of early settlers. The guided tour will be full of detailed history leaving you with an appreciation of our forefather's and will end with a German style meal. **Cost of the tour and lunch is \$19.50.**
- 2)** The Former Texas Ranger Heritage Center is packed with details of the history of the famous Texas Rangers and what is being done at its new location here in the Texas Hill Country. The site includes a preserved frontier fort that is well worth your time to explore. Buck and LaNett are especially proud of this tour, as both have ancestors who were former Texas Rangers. **Cost is donation only.** Should return to the motel approx. 3:00-3:30pm.
